"THE ROSE OF TRALEE"

Robert "Bob" Blennerhassett was c1840 was good friend and neighbour to William Pembroke Mulchinock; Who was Bob Blennerhassett and where did he live?
Poet William Pembroke Mulchinock (d.13.10.1864) was author of the famous Kerry ballad "The Rose of Tralee"; His parents Micheal Mulchinock & Margaret McCann (C.of I.) lived at "West Villa", near Tralee; Following Micheal's death in 1828 Mary O'Connor (aged about 17) of Brogue Lane, The Rock, Tralee was employed at West Villa, first as kitchen maid then as nursemaid; there she met William Mulchinock and became the inspiration for "The Rose of Tralee"; William left Tralee for India 1843 where he was a war correspondant, returning Spring 1849; Mary O'Connor died Spring 1849 and is buried at Clogherbrien; William m. Alicia Keogh & they went to NY, USA in 1849; they had two daughters, but separated; He returned to Ireland in 1855; The story refers to "...a dancing platform in Clahane, at the top of the glen..."
so West Villa may be at the south edge of Tralee town, between Tralee & Clahane
