he was mustered into service as a Private in Company A of the 17th New York Veteran Volunteer Infantry Regiment;

He served with this regiment through its campaigns from Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi, Alabama, and Georgia;

taken ill just before the campaign into South Carolina, he was taken to a hospital at Hilton Head, South Carolina,
